



Donation of Diabetes Supplies



The Donation of Supplies is Key to the Mission of the Diabetes Foundation

We are collecting unused, unopened, unexpired test strips, KetoStix, glucose meters, lancing devices as well as other diabetes supplies, for redistribution to individuals living with diabetes. All items are provided, free of charge, to individuals with diabetes who otherwise would go without these life saving devices.

LIST OF SUPPLIES WE ACCEPT

KetoStix

Boxes must be new and unopened with a minimum of three (3) months to use-by date. New, unopened boxes of any brands are accepted.

Glucose Meters

Meters must be in excellent working condition and have not been discontinued. The manufacturer of meters must be currently making test strips for that model to be accepted.

Lancing Devices

Unopened, new lancing devices from any brand are accepted.

Glucagon

All glucagon must have a minimum of three (3) months to use-by date. Lilly Glucagon, GlucaGen, and Baqsimi are all accepted.

Insulin Pump Supplies

We accept all major brands of insulin pump supplies: Medtronic, Tandem, OmniPod, InSet, and iLet. OmniPod pods must have at least three (3) months to expiration. All other brands' supplies must have at least six (6) months remaining until expiration and sealed in original boxes. Gently used, working OmniPod controllers are accepted. We are unable to accept donations of tubed insulin pumps.

Glucose Test Strips

Unused, sealed glucose test strips must have a minimum of ninety (90) days to use-by date. All brands of sealed test strips are accepted.

Lancets

All lancets must have a tamper-proof factory seal with a minimum of seven (7) months to use-by date. We are only permitted to work with factory sealed lancets. Any type or brand of lancet are accepted. If no date is printed, the sterility of lancets lasts five years from the date of manufacturing.

Continuous Glucose Monitor (CGM) Supplies

We accept Dexcom, FreeStyle Libre, and Medtronic Guardian sensors with at least ninety (90) days until expiration. All CGM readers are accepted and must be new. Dexcom transmitters must have at least four (4) months until expiration.

**If the item you are donating does not have an expiration date, we can accept it up to five years from the manufacturing date.*
